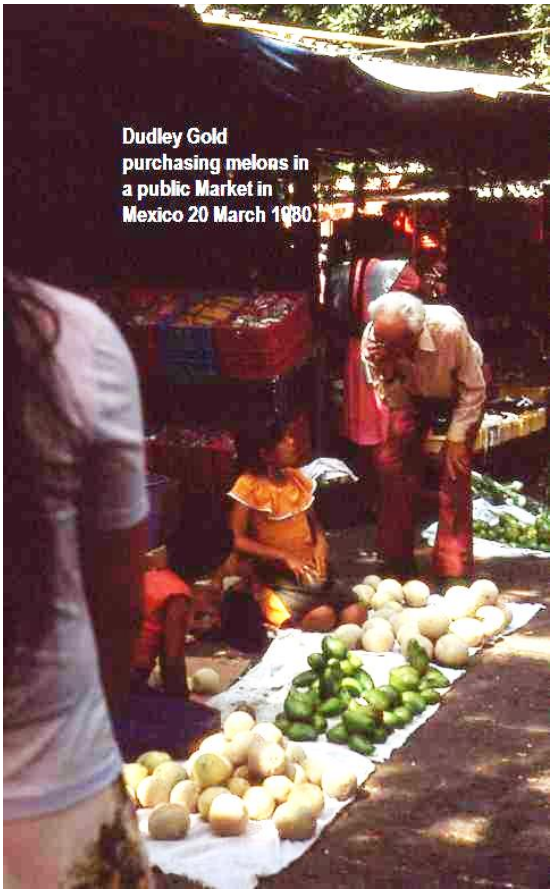

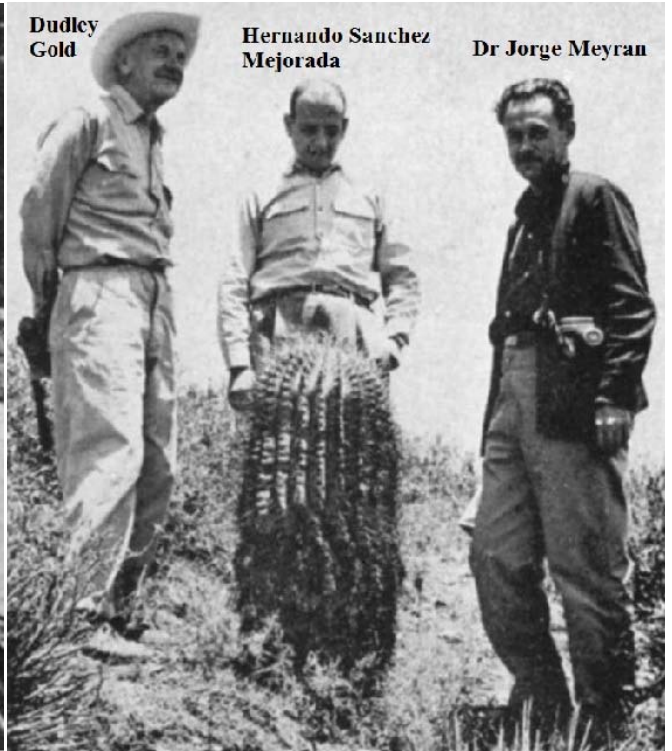

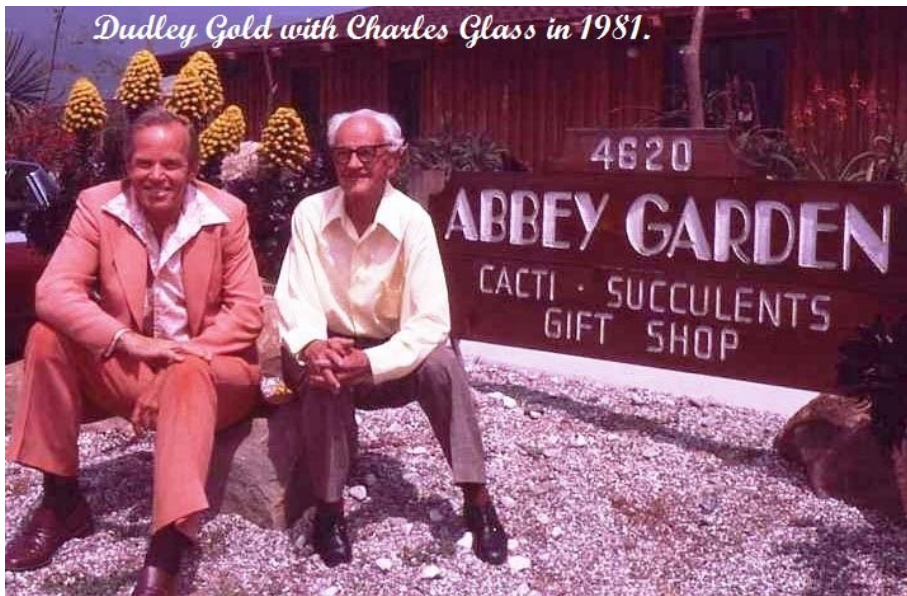

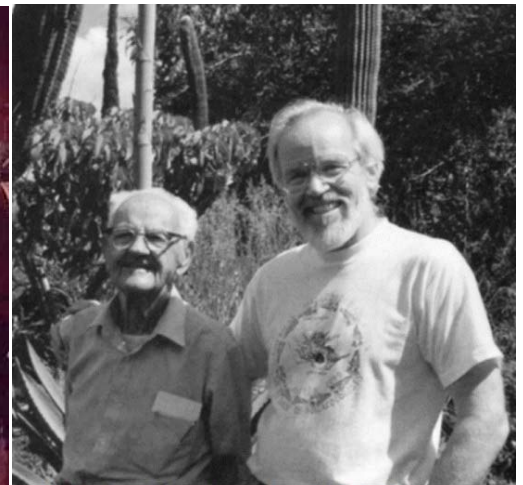

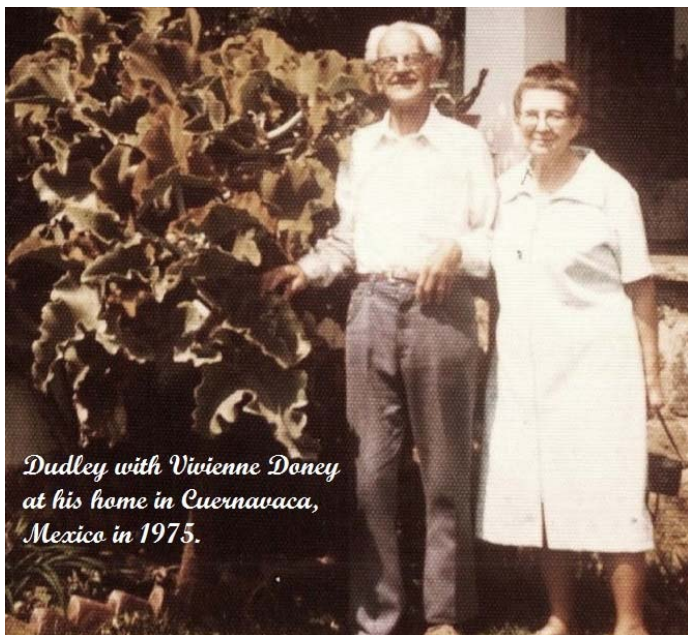
With a mature specimen of *Ferocactus haematacanthus* near Canada Morelos, Puebla, Mexico in 1967.



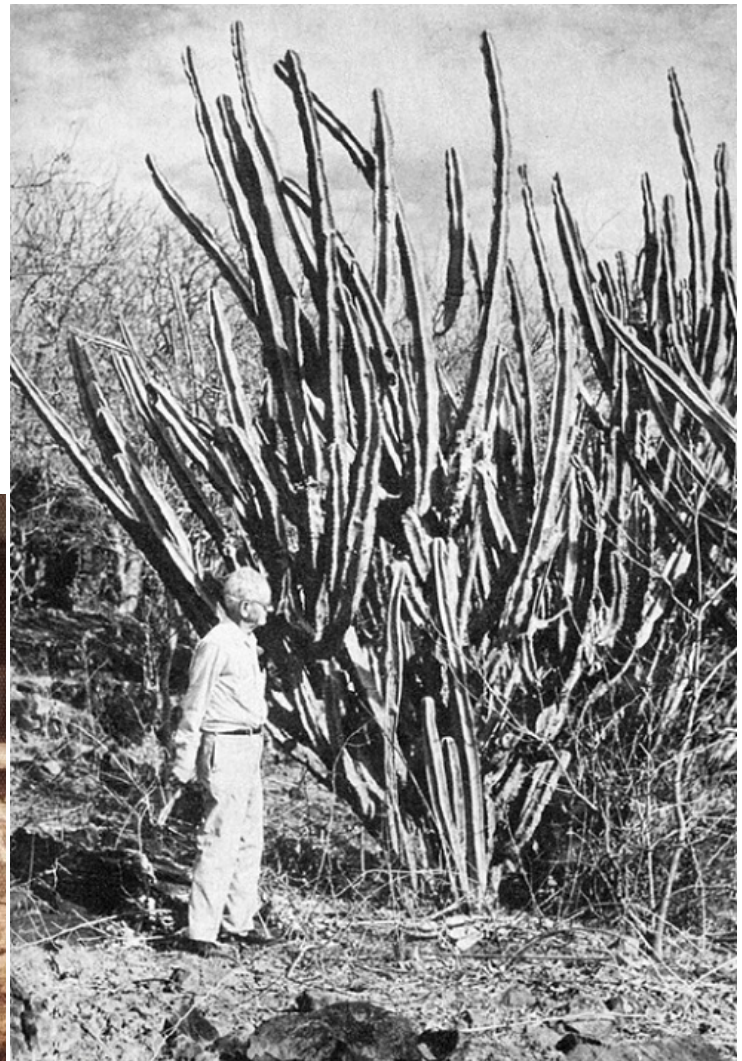
