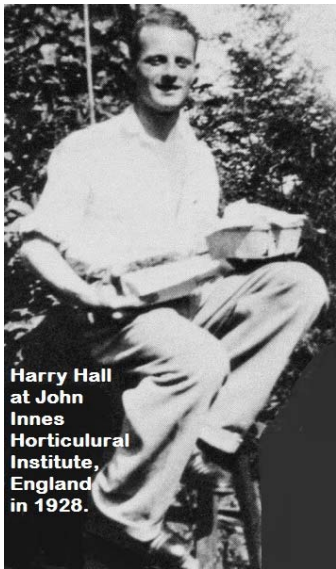


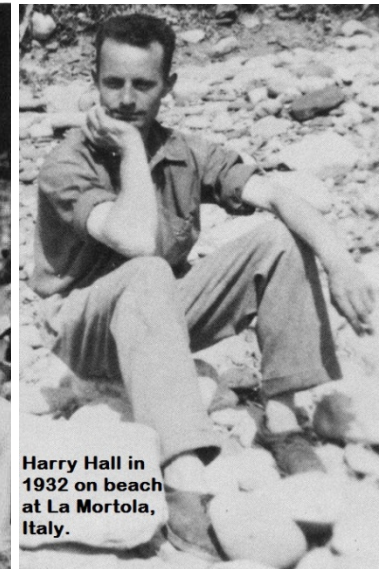

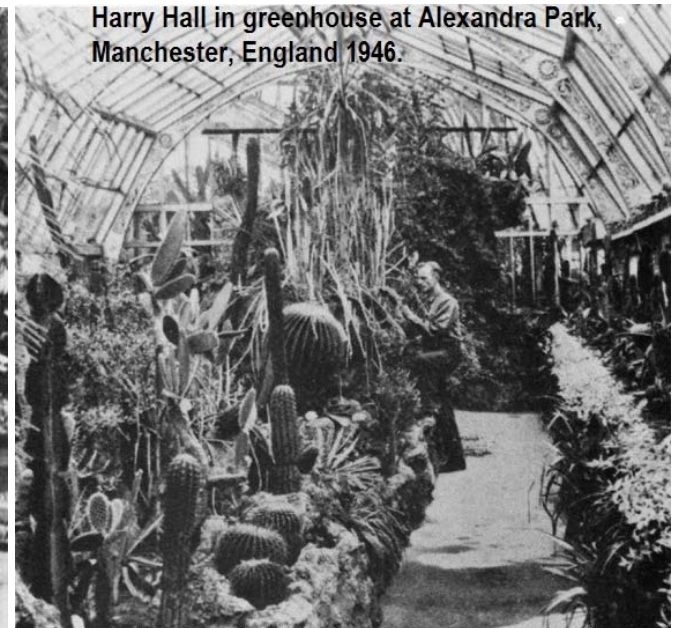

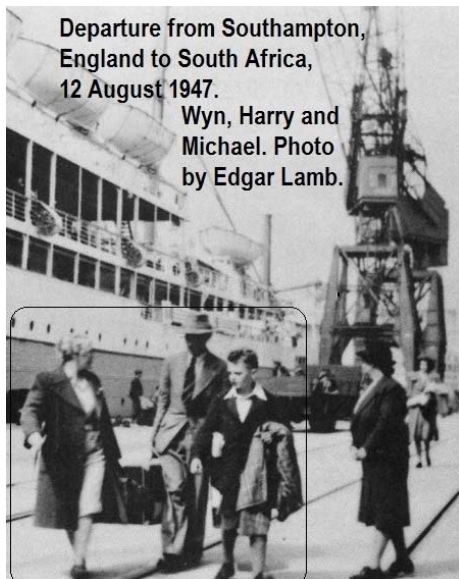

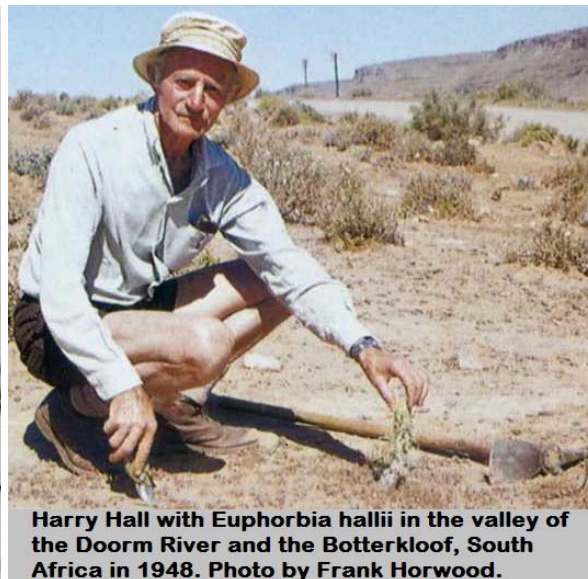


Harry Hall in greenhouse at Alexandra Park, Manchester, England 1946.

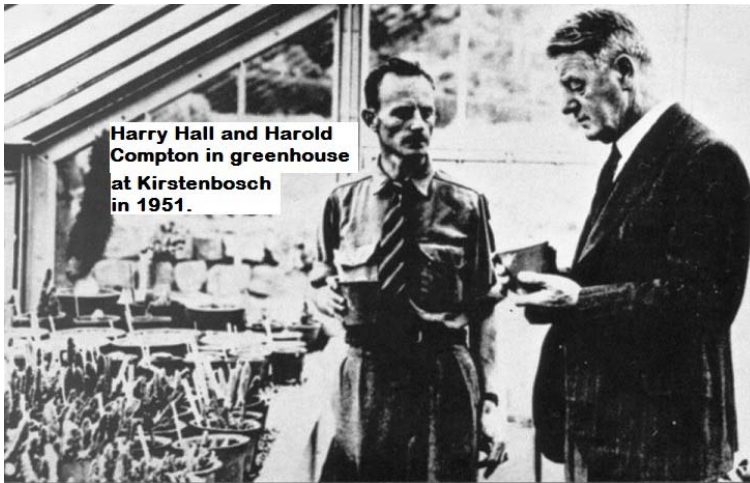


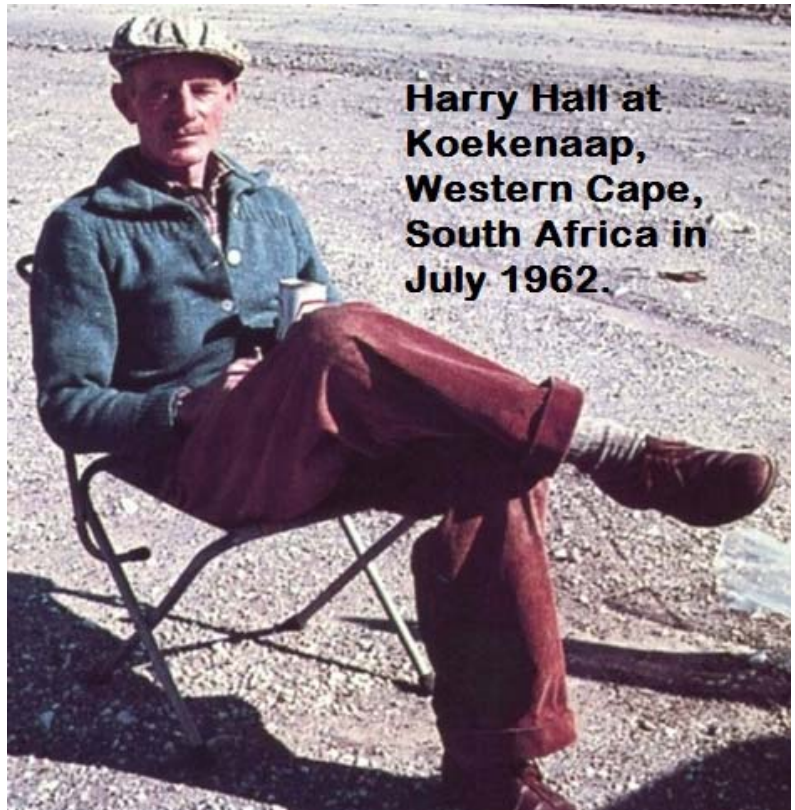


FIG. 100. Mr. Harry Hall, of the National Botanic Garden, Kirstenbosch, South Africa. Photo taken in the Ceres Karoo.

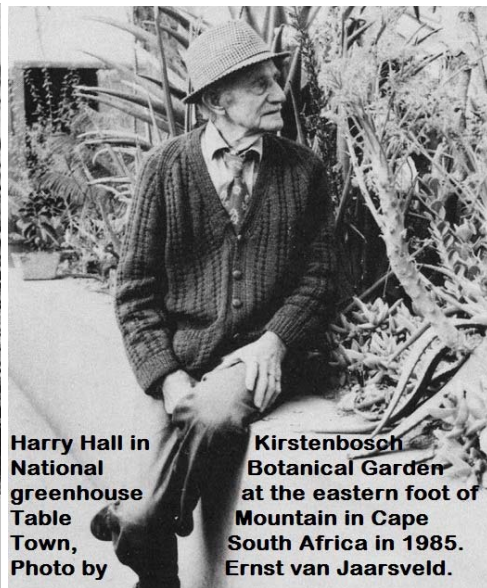

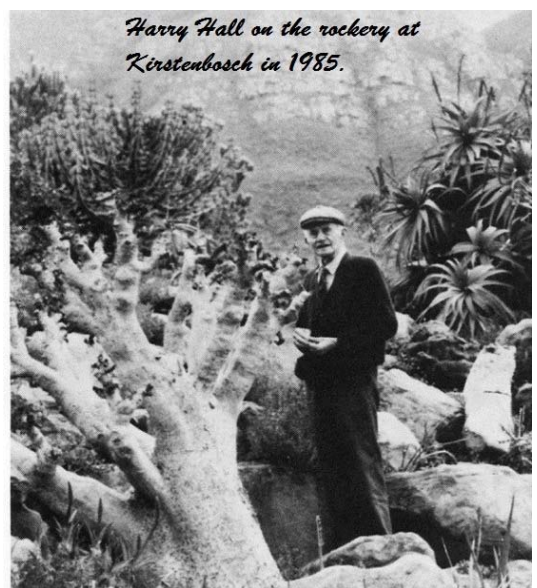

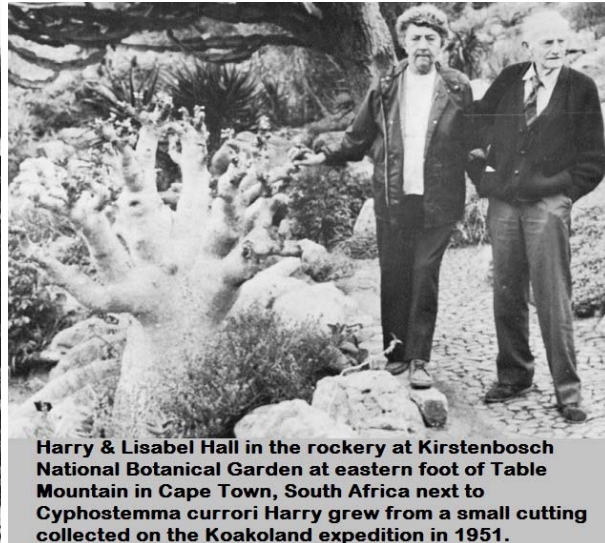
